



Application fee waiver request form

Introduction

One of The Lir National Academy of Dramatic Art's key aims is to ensure fair access to training for the most talented students, regardless of their background. As a result, The Lir have committed to providing application fee waivers to make sure that applicants from low income households are encouraged to apply.

Eligibility

To be eligible for an application fee waiver, applicants must meet the following essential criteria:

Irish, EU, EEA or Swiss National or have specific leave to remain in the State

Applying to an undergraduate course (Foundation Diploma in Acting and Theatre Studies or Bachelor in Acting)

No previous first degree qualification

From a household income of less than €39,875 per year before tax

In addition to the essential criteria listed above, applicants should also tick the boxes below that are relevant to them:

Your household income is less than €23,500 per year

You have more than one dependent (under 23) in your household

You have declared a disability

You are an estranged student (not supported by your family)

You've attended a primary or a post primary school in the School Support Programme (SSP) under the DEIS action plan for educational inclusion

How the process works

Please complete page 1 and 2 and send your form and COPIES of your proof of household income. Proof of income may include:

- Personal* or parental** P60s (2021)
- confirmation of income-related benefit payments (eg Jobseeker's Allowance, Disability Allowance, Income Support)
- evidence of tax return from the financial year 2021

If you feel that you qualify under the eligibility criteria but are unsure what evidence to provide, or you need assistance completing the form, please email admissions@thelir.ie with the subject line 'APPLICATION FEE WAIVER'

Please email your form and evidence to the email address above.

Once your application fee waiver request has been assessed, you will be contacted by The Lir to confirm the outcome.

If you do not meet the criteria you will be required to pay the application fee.
